

## Strategy Meeting 12<sup>th</sup> Aug 2009

**Blairingone.** Five people agreed with map. Four people wanted less development. No one wanted more.

We should emphasise that this extent of development should be dependent on an increase in the amenities of the village and a bypass. The plan shows the absolute maximum possible development.

**Carnbo.** There should only be infill development if any at all. There was no appetite for any change to existing village envelope.

**Crook of Devon.** 64 responses were received. 35 agreed with the plan and 24 disagreed. 5 were non-committal. The meeting discussed whether to remove CD13. It was agreed that it should be removed on the basis of the number of people objecting to it specifically in the questionnaire, the large number of people who objected to the recent application and the result of the appeal. The developer's lack of co-operation should also be taken into consideration.

There was general comment about flooding east of the watershed. It was agreed that development of CD4 and CD11 should be subject to rigorous environmental and flooding assessment.

**Powmill.** There were 31 responses – 24 agreed with the map, 7 disagreed. It was decided that we would like to see the Hotel site and the steading west of P3 sorted out and developed. The new area of woodland should be extended in P2. The appropriate place for the village green would depend on where development took place and should be decided after discussion with Environmental Services.

**Rumbling Bridge.** There were 14 responses – 11 agreed with the map. It was agreed that Rumbling Bridge had no capacity for any further development.
